

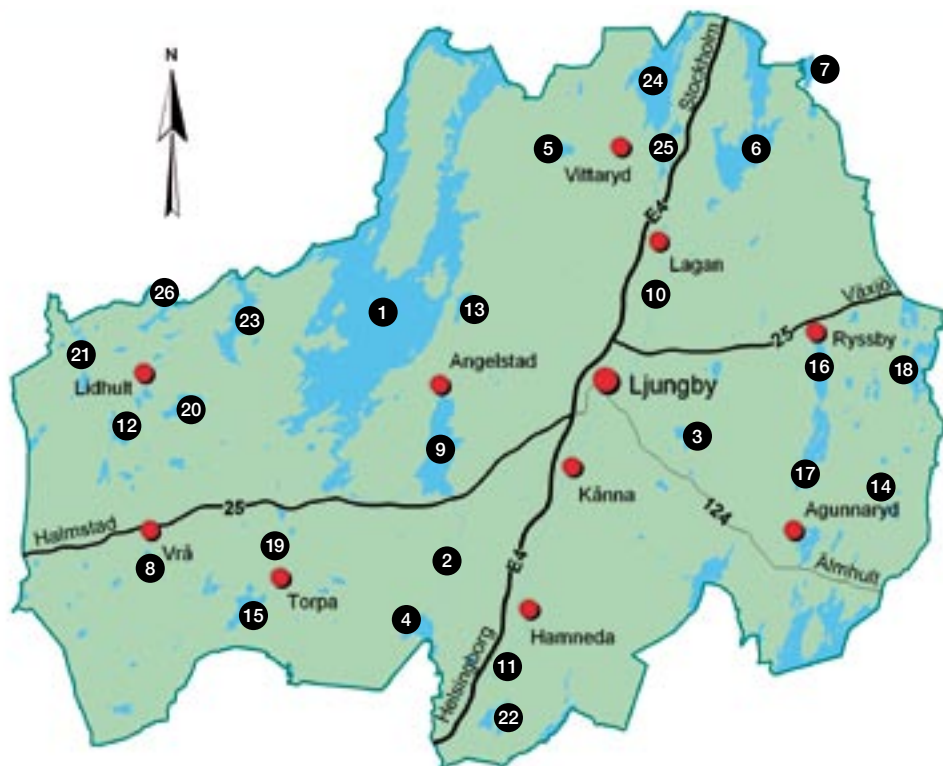
FISHING GUIDE

LJUNGBY MUNICIPALITY





Fishing in all waters require a valid fishing permit. Contact the tourist information office in Ljungby for further information. There are specific rules and regulations concerning equipment and fish for different lakes. See fishing permits and information from the fishing ground area concerned.

1 Bolmen. Bolmen is one of the largest lakes in Sweden, placed in spectacular nature. There are an immense number of islands, bays and coves where you can fish. You are most likely to catch pike, zander and perch but eel, burbot, bream, tench and roach can also be found. There are well-developed constructions of ramps for launchings of boats. Motorboats can be rented at camping grounds, from fishing guides and others. A navigational chart is available for sale and an electronic navigational chart will be available in short.

Accommodation: Camping grounds and cabins. Jetties suitable for handicapped people are situated by the bridge in Tannåker and at Mjälén. A country shop is located close to the lake.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing, coarse fishing and trolling.

2 Bolmån. Bolmån flows between lakes Kösen and Exen, and is a paradise for the fly-fisher who wants to experience genuine fishing in streaming water in a beautiful natural environment. There is stretch of land that is especially designed for fly-fishing. Perch and pike can also be fished. The season lasts from the 1st of April to the 15th of September.

Recommended fishing: fly fishing and lure fishing.

3 Bräkentorpasjön. This is one of the many smaller lakes that can be found in Ljungby municipality where fishing for perch and pike at times can be brilliant. The lake is fairly shallow. Boats can be rented and boat-launching sites exist.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.

4 Exen. This lake suits those who want to spend their vacation fishing pike, zander and perch. Eel, burbot, bream, tench and roach can also be found. Boats can be rented and boat-launching sites exist.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing, coarse fishing and trolling.

5 Flyxen. This is a great lake for perch where it is best to use a fixed spool reel and a spinning rod. The lake is also very good for fishing during the wintertime. Boats can be rented and boat-launching sites exist.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.

6 Flåren. This lake is barren and stony and resembles the environment in the archipelago. Here you can experience the feeling of solitude in the wilderness. The depth varies greatly with a maximum of 20 metres. Be cautious of stones and grounds, as they are not all marked. There is primarily pike, zander and perch, but can also eel, burbot, bream, tench and roach to be found in the lake. There are boat-launching ramps, and boats can be rented.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing, coarse fishing and trolling.

7 Furen. This is a lake that is famous for its great zander fishing, but you are also very likely to catch perch and pike. There is a good boat-launching site in the southern part of the lake. There is a detailed navigational chart of the lake but note that the grounds are not marked. Boats can be rented.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing, coarse fishing and trolling.

8 Krokån. The area comprises: stream Krokån in the County of Kronoberg and the following lakes; Garsjön, Grunnhultasjön, Hjortserysjön, Ljushultssjön, Rammsjön and Stönjasjön. There is a boat-launching site at Ljushultssjön.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and fly fishing.

9 Kösen. This is a lake that is often forgotten because of its proximity to Lake Bolmen, but it is a great alternative especially during windy days. The lake is renowned for its large-sized pikes and good fishing for zander. There is also trout, rainbow trout, eel, burbot, bream, tench and roach. A detailed chart of depths with marked grounds is available. There are boat-launching sites by the bridge at Bolmarö and in Angelstad. Boats can be rented. The area also comprises the river Bolmån from the bridge in Skeen to the outflow in Kösen.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing, coarse fishing and trolling.

10 Lagan-Skåån. The fishing permit is valid for Lagan south of Lake Vidöstern through to the new bridge in Hamneda, and stream Skåån south of Lake Flåren to river Lagaån. A map of the area is available for sale. The fishing is mainly for pike, zander, perch, trout and rainbow trout, but there is also eel, burbot, bream, tench and roach. All sportfishing equipment is allowed. A maximum of two salmon fishes per day and fishing permit is allowed. There is a boat-launching site just north of Ljungby. A tip: Lagan-Skåån is rather untouched water that may offer many pleasant fishing surprises!

Recommended fishing: lure fishing, coarse fishing and trolling.



11 Lagan (Hamnedå-Traryd). This interesting fishing-water is set in gorgeous nature that stretches from the new bridge in Hamnedå to the power plant in Traryd. There is mainly pike, zander, perch and trout but eel, burbot, bream, tench and roach can also be caught. Boats can be rented and launched in Traryd.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing, coarse fishing and trolling.

12 Southern Lidhult. The area comprises the lakes: Askåken, Knutsnabben, Kulken, Sandsjön, Ältasjön and Örsjön. Boats can be rented.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.

13 Lillasjön. This lake is rich in reed why it is best to fish from a smaller boat or canoe. Pike and perch can be caught.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.

14 Målasjöarna. The area is situated between Agunnaryd and Vislanda and comprises the following water bodies: Holmasjön, Hästagöl, Kalasjön, Karlasjön, Kroksjön, Ljussjön, Muggobodasjön, Målasjön, Tvålsjön, Lilla Helgeån and brooks and small streams in the water catchment. Boats can be rented and launching sites exist.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.

15 Måen. This lake is shallow and stony but absolutely perfect for those who wish to fish for perch. Pike and, occasionally, zander can also be caught. Boats can be rented.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.

16 Ryssbysjön. Pike, zander, perch and eel, burbot, bream, tench and roach are to be found. There is a good boat-launching site in the northern part of the lake. A jetty suitable for handicapped people is present.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing, coarse fishing and trolling.

17 Stensjön-Agunnarydssjön. Stensjön is connected to Agunnarydssjön through the small stream Helge å about five kilometres south of the small town Ryssby. Fishing in the lakes is mainly for pike and perch but zander, bream, tench and roach can also be caught. There are launching sites for boats by the canoe camping site at stream Helge å, and by the swimming area. Boats can be rented. Other lakes in area are: Agnsjön, Farsjön and Helge å from Sunnerå to the outlet of Agunnarydssjön.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.



- 18 Tjurken.** This fishing ground area comprises seven lakes that makes up in total more than 1,000 hectares of fishing-waters. The lakes are: Tjurken, Borrassjön, Olasjön, Trehörningarna, Fenen, Immen and Malasjön. Lake Tjurken, which is closest to the village of Piggaboda, is the largest lake in the area with more than 30 islands and with an average depth of three to four metres, and the maximum depth is twelve metres. In the area there is plenty of pike, perch, zander and eel but also fishes that are well-suited for angling like bream, tench and roach. Boat launching sites are present and boats can be rented. There is a brochure with an overview map of the area.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing, coarse fishing and trolling in Tjurken.

- 19 Torpa-Hinneryd.** This area comprises for example the lakes and streams: Hinnerydssjöarna, Mäen, Skärsjön, Boasjön, Ljungsjön (in the parish of Annerstad), Bodasjön, Källhultssjön, Vitasjön, Rukesjön, Risasjön. Hinnån, Torpaån, Bodabäcken and several inflowing water courses. In the lakes Hinnerydssjöarna there is trout and rainbow trout. The maximum allowed catch is three fishes per day and fishing permit, and the minimum allowed size is 26 centimetres. All sport fishing equipment are allowed. In lake Mäen there is some zander.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.

- 20 Torserydssjön.** The lake is situated southeast of the small town Lidhult and has a reputation for large and nice perch. Of course there are also pikes in the lake and probably some zander as well.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.

- 21 Transjön-Svansjön.** The fishing ground area is situated west of the small town of Lidhult and fishing is mainly for perch and pike. The following lakes are part of the area: Hallsjön, Lillasjön, Stora Svansjön, Lilla Svansjön, Strutssjön, Sutaressjön, Transjön and Åkersjön. Boats can be rented.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.

22 Tuvesjön-Enasjön. The lakes are situated northeast of the village Traryd and primarily the fishing is for pikes and perch. Some zander can be found. There is a possibility to launch smaller boats by the swimming area in Stighult and by the Enasjön canal. Boats can be rented.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.

23 Unnen. This is a medium-sized lake with a vigorous population of pike, zander and perch. The lake is very stony and there are great variations in depth. Grounds and stones are not marked. Boats can be rented.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.

24 Vidöstern. This is a large lake with very good fishing for pike, zander and perch, suitable for spinning and advanced trolling from boats. The water is also very good for fishing tench, bream and eel. The depths vary and the grounds are carefully marked. There are well-developed constructions of ramps for launchings of boats. A detailed navigational chart is available. Boats can be rented.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.

25 Vällingasjön. A scenic Put & Take water with trout, rainbow trout and brown trout that is run by the sportfishing club *Spöfolket*. Angling with natural baits is not allowed. Fishing from float tube is allowed but not from boats. There is a vending machine for fishing permits by the lake. Jig is allowed as soon as the ice is safe.

Recommended fishing: fly fishing and lure fishing.

26 Yasjön-Nejsjön. There is pike, perch, roach, tench, burbot, bream and eel in the lakes. Boats can be launched at Nejsjön (near Mjöhult). Boats can be rented.

Recommended fishing: lure fishing and coarse fishing.
